**LENT PRAYER** Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on 14<sup>th</sup> February and as in recent years, each Tuesday evening at 7.00pm we will have a time of prayer. On Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> February we will resume our Silent Prayer for 40 minutes or so. The following three weeks will be a celebration of the Stations of the Cross and on March 19<sup>th</sup> we will have a time of Taizé prayer. On March 26<sup>th</sup>, we will have our Lent reconciliation service. All are welcome to join us for any or all of these evenings.

**ASH WEDNESDAY** is this week and the start of our Lent season. Although not a holy day of obligation, many people like to start the season of Lent with Mass so we will have our usual 9.15am Mass and an evening Mass at 7.00pm.

**FAMILY FAST DAY** in support of CAFOF will take place on Friday  $23^{rd}$  February. Envelopes for your donations are at the back of the church and a second collection will be taken up on  $24^{th}$  –  $25^{th}$  Feb. **LENT LUNCHES** is an initiative of Churches Together in Faversham to raise money for charitable purposes. A simple soup, bread and cheese lunch is provided in the Baptist church hall for a suggested donation of £3 per person and takes place each Friday of Lent, starting on  $16^{th}$  February. On March  $1^{st}$  it is the turn of our parish to organise the lunch and we need volunteers to make vegetarian soup, as well as serve and washup on the day. If you are interested in getting involved, please let us know. Setup is from 11am and lunch is served from 12noon till 1.30pm.

Following an initiative of the diocese we have signed up with DONA online donations and digital collection plate to install a terminal for card donations. You can use the terminal to make your weekly donation, to pay for cards from beside the display or make a donation for candles from the shrine. Second collection offerings can also be made.
