**LENT PRAYER** On each Tuesday evening at 7.00pm during lent we will have a time of prayer. On Tuesday  $20^{th}$  February we will resume our Silent Prayer for 40 minutes or so. The following three weeks will be a celebration of the Stations of the Cross and on March  $19^{th}$  we will have a time of Taizé prayer. On March  $26^{th}$ , we will have our Lent reconciliation service. All are welcome to join us for any or all of these evenings.

**FAMILY FAST DAY** in support of CAFOF will take place on Friday  $23^{rd}$  February. Envelopes for your donations are at the back of the church and a second collection will be taken up on  $24^{th}$  –  $25^{th}$  Feb. **LENT LUNCHES** is an initiative of Churches Together in Faversham to raise money for charitable purposes. A simple soup, bread and cheese lunch is provided in the Baptist church hall for a suggested donation of £3 per person and takes place each Friday of Lent, starting on  $16^{th}$  February.
