THE TRIDUUM Rather than three different liturgies spread across Thursday, Friday and Saturday, the church celebrates them as one continuous journey. Beginning with the celebration of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, we journey through Good Friday and the Passion, into the silence of Holy Saturday and the celebration of light, baptism and resurrection at the Vigil after dark on Saturday. We are invited to make the effort to celebrate the whole of the Triduum in a spirit of openness to God at work in our lives. **LENT RECONCILIATION SERVICE** will be celebrated on Tuesday at 7.00pm – an opportunity for us to come together as a parish community to reflect on our lives and our calling to pray for God's healing in our world and our lives. Fr Mark from Herne Bay will join us for the evening as there will be an opportunity for individual confessions.

ST OSCAR ROMERO'S MESSAGE TO THE CHURCH OF TODAY: "A civilisation of love is not sentimentality; it is justice and truth. Justice is a sacred right of all human beings conferred by God himself. It is embedded in the very essence of the gospel message. A civilisation of love that did not demand justice for people would not be true civilisation.... Because of this, it is only a caricature of love when we try to patch up with charity what is owed in justice, when we cover with an appearance of benevolence what we are failing in social justice. True love means demanding what is just." But it is not enough to demand justice. The civilization of love also demands truth ... And truth is what is lacking in our situation ... When the truth is spoken, it gives offence, and the voices that speak the truth are silenced.... For the Church to preach this civilization of love, she must not be afraid to unmask and denounce the injustices and abuses, for she must always speak of truth and justice." April 12 1979
