PARISH FINANCE REQUEST As you may know, the parish (and diocese) banks with NatWest and the parish is part of the diocesan finance central banking services. Unfortunately, the NatWest branch here in Faversham is closing down in August and this will mean that we have to go to either Canterbury or Sittingbourne for paying in cash, cheques and so forth.

To minimise the volume of cash, we are making an appeal that those of you who make a weekly offering by cash or cheque, might think about making a standing order instead. This can be done on a weekly or monthly basis as best suits you and will minimise our trips to the bank with cash. It will also reduce administration time spent on recording the weekly offerings. If you are a gift-aid donor, this will not be affected.

For now, we are asking that you might consider:

- if you already have a standing order set up for some time, revisit it and check that it is as you would like it to be. If you can increase it, that would be helpful and if you need to reduce it, that is understandable too - we know that circumstances change.
- if you cannot do a standing order, please make offerings by cheque wherever possible (payable to RCAS Faversham)
- if you are not already signed up for gift-aid, please do so if you are eligible

We are very grateful for your generosity to the parish. Please don't feel under pressure to make any offering if you cannot afford it, particularly with the increased cost of living that is affecting everyone.
